**ARL Dedham to Host Rabies & Microchip Clinic**

*No appointment necessary, walk-ins are welcome*

The Animal Rescue League of Boston (ARL) is set to hold its annual Rabies and Microchip clinic for dogs and cats on Saturday, April 27, at the Dedham Animal Care and Adoption Center, located at 55 Anna's Place in Dedham, MA.

The clinic will be held from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and no appointments are necessary, walk-ins are welcome.

The cost for the rabies vaccine is \$10, while a microchip will be \$20.

Rabies vaccines are mandated by state law, and having a pet microchipped greatly increases the chance of being reunited should the animal become lost.
