Community urged to donate to support Cape Cod patients

On Monday, January 30, the Animal Rescue League of Boston's (ARL) Brewster Animal Care and Adoption Center will host the Cape Cod Healthcare Blood Mobile, for a blood drive and invite members of the community to donate to help support patients at both Cape Cod Hospital and Falmouth Hospital.

The blood drive will be held from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. in the parking lot of ARL's Brewster facility located at 3981 Main St. (Route 6A) in Brewster.

An appointment is required to donate, and can be made through Cape Cod Healthcare's Donor Portal at <u>https://srt.capecodhealth.org/donorportal/</u>.

The blood drive is open to anyone who hasn't donated blood since September 18, 2022, and all donations will stay on Cape Cod to help our friends, relatives and neighbors in need at Cape Cod Hospital and Falmouth Hospital.
